Occurs when a person consciously tries to force these feelings out of awareness


### Dissociation

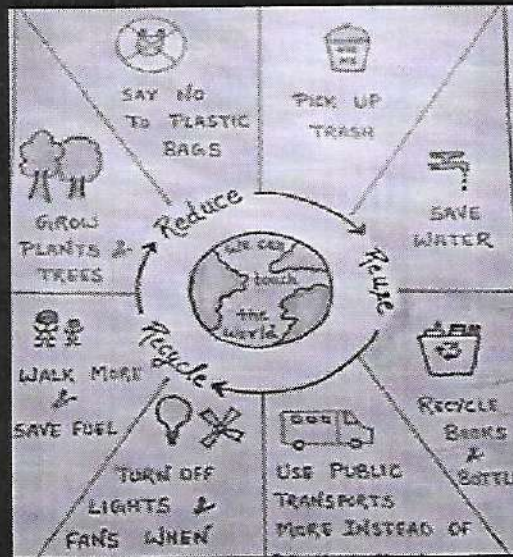
