6. Accounting & Trading Essentials for Employability - Advanced Tally with GST

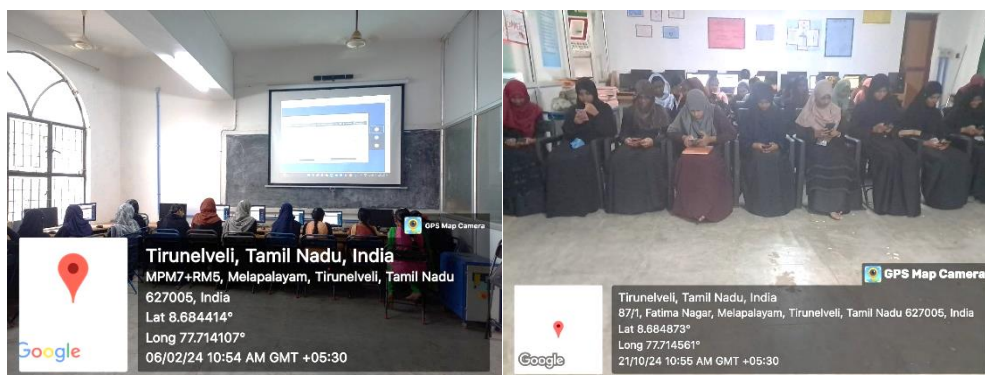

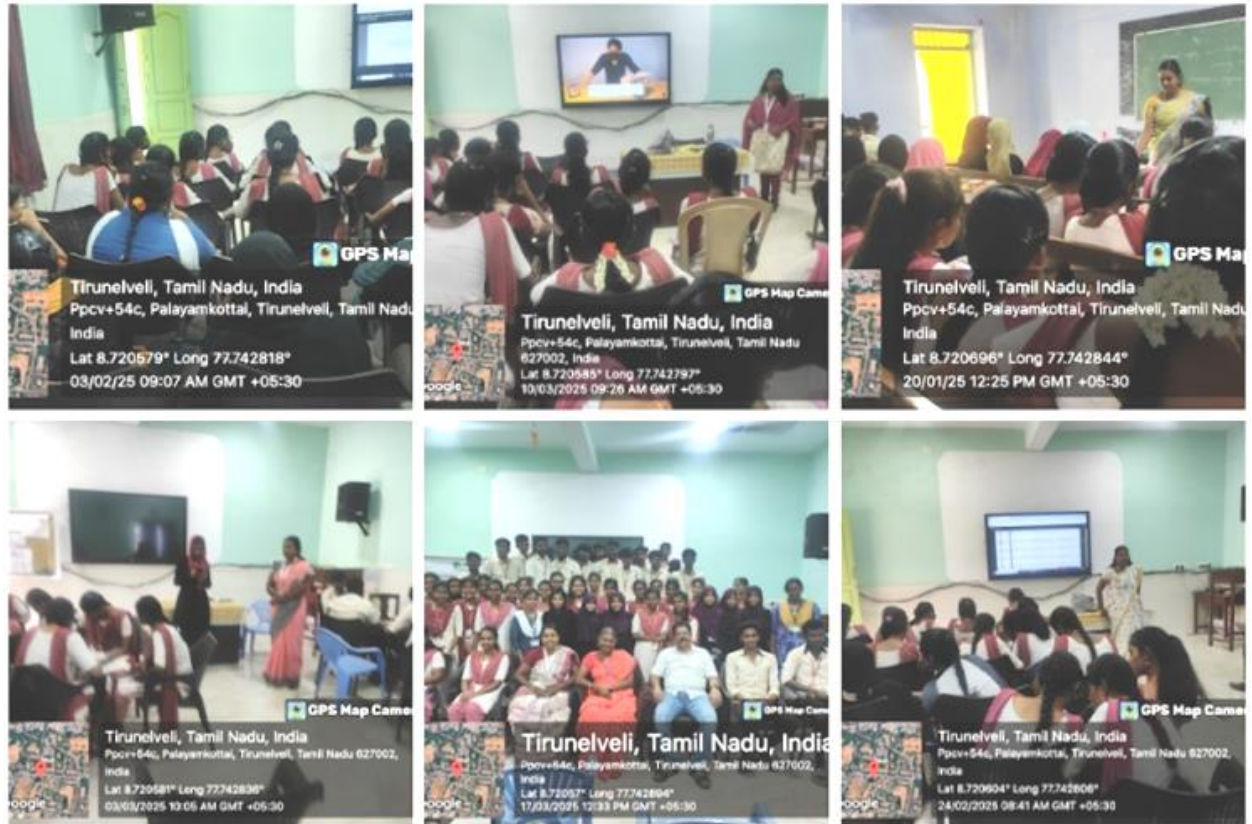

8. Sustainability & Green Chemistry in EV Sector

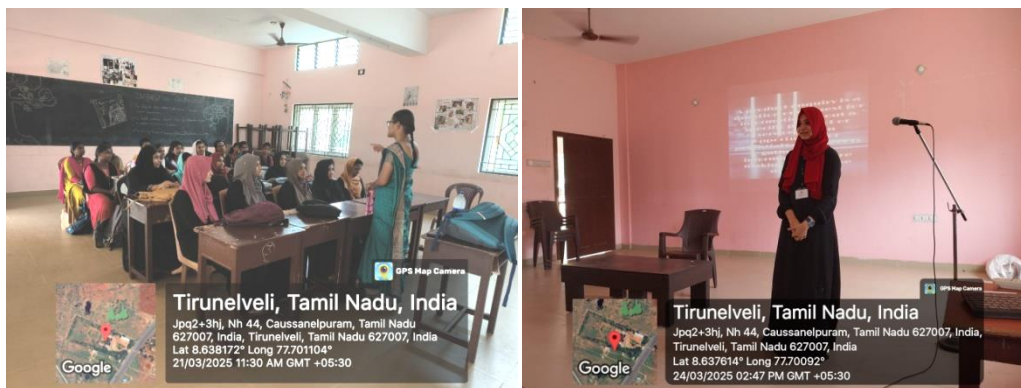
