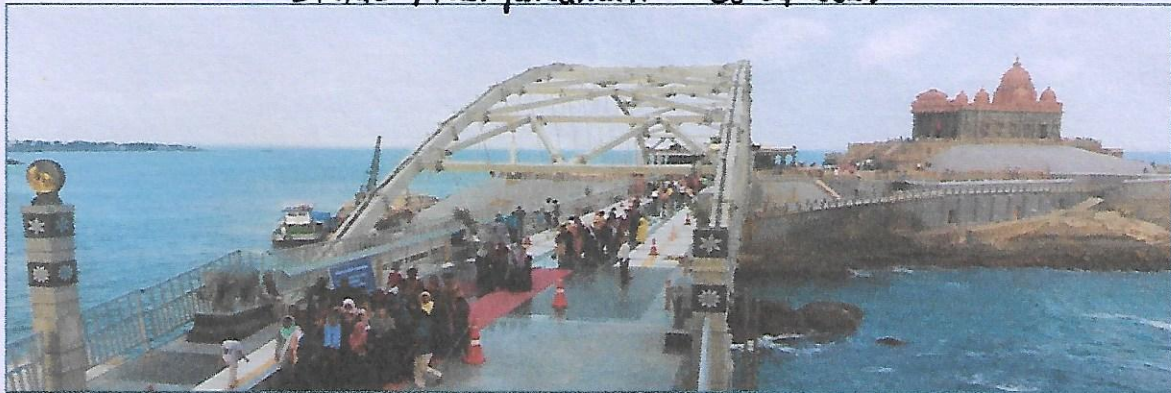
Conclusion

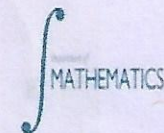




